**Call to Order**

A quorum being present, Mayor Weekley called the meeting to order at 10:50 am.

**Alport/Boehmer:**

**WHEREAS** the Resort Village of the District of Katepwa is encountering an extreme threat to Flooding, that requires prompt action to prevent harm or damage to the safety, health or welfare of persons located within the boundaries, of the Resort Village of the District of Katepwa and to prevent damage to property within those boundaries.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** pursuant to Section 20 of *The Emergency Planning Act*, Chapter. E-8.1 of the Statutes of Saskatchewan, the Council of the Resort Village of the District of Katepwa declares that a local emergency exists, for the District of Katepwa in the Province of Saskatchewan, Canada From this 30 day of April, 2011.

The making of this decision enables Council to enact reasonable measures as listed in Section 21 of the Emergency Planning Act to deal with and alleviate the effect of this disaster.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF** of the Council of the Resort Village of the District of Katepwa has by resolution carried, declared this local emergency this 30 day of April, 2011.

**43/2011**      **Burnett/Horvath:** that the District of Katepwa apply to Saskatchewan Corrections, Public Safety and Policing to be designated an eligible assistance area under the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP) which provides financial assistance for restoring essential services and property both public and private as a result of substantial damages caused by 2011 spring flooding which started on April 11, 2011 and which will end when Katepwa Lake recedes to normal levels.

**Carried**

**44/2011**      **Horvath:** That the District of Katepwa temporarily restrict access to all recreational boats from any of the Districts water access until such time that the water has returned to normal levels.

Whereas: Boats being used as emergency situations be granted accesses;

Whereas: Boats being used access personal property and are not causing wake be granted access;

Whereas: People wishing to remove boats from their property be granted access providing they create no wake;  
And

Whereas: the District is notified prior to using such accesses.

Anyone in violation of this restriction WILL BE FINE \$5000.
