BYLAW NO. 1-07

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the District of Katepwa, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the District of Katepwa; and
 - b) "Municipality" means the District of Katepwa.
- 2. Council is hereby authorized appoint a Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality as named by resolution of Council.
- 3. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving 30 days written notice.
- 4. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
 - a) to enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality
 - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
 - c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate

5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on April 16, 2007
